



How to apply for an EV charger incentive in Ireland

EV home charger grant:

- Click [here](#) for a list of eligible cars.
- Complete the online [application form](#).
To complete the form, you'll need:
 1. Your MPRN (meter point reference number), found on your electricity bill.
 2. The application ID from your car dealer if the EV is a new car.
- Once approved, you'll receive a 'Letter of Offer' by post within 7 days. This will be issued with a payment request form. From there you'll have 6 months to carry out the installation.
- Once installation is done, fill out the payment request form. Get your electrician to help. They need to provide you with a completed copy of the [Certificate for Existing Installations](#).
- Post your completed payment request form to the address indicated on the form, along with:
 1. Certificate for Existing Installations
 2. Copy of the test record sheet from your electrician
 3. A copy of the vehicle registration form if your EV is not new and purchased in Ireland.
 4. Photographs of the installed charge point and your EV, showing the vehicle registration number.
- Applications take around 6-8 weeks.
